Re: Butler County, Millville MHP, NPDES Permit Violations

Dear Mr. Colwell:

We have reviewed your Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) covering the month of June 2007 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0133736; OEPA Permit # 1PV00124\*AD). The specific instances of noncompliance and deficiencies were as follows:

We have also attempted to review your Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) covering the months of January through May 2007 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit. The Millville MHP has failed to submit these MORs.

The NPDES Permit also requires in Part III, Section 4 titled "Reporting" that the MORs be submitted either as a hard copy or as an electronic submission. The MORs are required to be submitted to the Ohio EPA, Central Office. The June 2007 MORs were faxed to the SWDO. The Ohio EPA, Central Office has failed to receive these MORs. This method for submitting the MORs does not comply with the NPDES Permit. The Millville MHP must correctly submit these MORs.

On March 27, 2007, a Compliance Evaluation Inspection was conducted at this facility. On April 2, 2007, I wrote to you about this inspection. The Millville MHP has failed to address the areas noted in the report summary. The Millville MHP must address this inspection report as soon as possible.


Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES Permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

Please inform this office, in writing, within ten days of receipt of this notification as to the reasons for the above referenced violations, as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations. Your response should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the actions. Future violations must be reported as required by the NPDES Permit as detailed in Part III.12 titled "Noncompliance Notification."
