Dear Mr. Roberds:

We have received your self-monitoring reports covering the months of September 2006 through May 2007 for the above-referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of noncompliance and deficiencies were as follows:

Schedule of Compliance - The Schedule of Compliance (Part I.C.a) requires Enon Heights to submit a Permit-to-Install (PTI) application and detail plans to Ohio EPA for plant and sewer improvements not later than May 1, 2006. As of the date of this Notice of Violation, Ohio EPA has not received the PTI application and detail plans in violation of Part I.C.a. Immediately submit the PTI application and detail plans.

Schedule of Compliance - The Schedule of Compliance (Part I.C.b) requires Enon Heights to commence construction for plant and sewer system improvements not January 1, 2007. As of the date of this Notice of Violation, Ohio EPA has not received notice that construction has begun in violation of Part I.C.b.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.


