**RE: Return to Compliance**

Dear Mr. McCray:

On December 21, 2011, Mark Mansfield and I conducted an inspection of the Coshocton Landfill. During our inspection we reviewed the daily logs and visited the working face of the landfill.

On September 15, 2011 Ohio EPA sent Coshocton Landfill a Notice of Violation with the following citations:

*OAC Rule 3745-27-19(B)(2)* - The proposed facility shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of the application.

*OAC Rule 3745-27-19(E)(7)(e)* - The owner or operator shall ensure that all waste admitted to the sanitary landfill facility is deposited at the working face, spread in layers not more than two feet thick, and compacted to the smallest practical volume.

During my inspection of Coshocton Landfill on December 21, 2011, the compactor was in use and the working face was spread in layers not more than 2 feet thick. Based on these observations Coshocton Landfill is in substantial compliance with OAC Rule 3745-27.
