Dear Ms. Neely:

Thank you for your November 21, 2011 response to Ohio EPA's November 17, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. The response listed measures City Wide Towing & Recovery was taking to eliminate the release of automotive fluids to the environment. Ohio EPA also conducted a site visit on January 10, 2012 to determine the cleanup of stained soils discovered during the November 1, 2011 complaint investigation. During the site visit Ohio EPA did not observe any releases of automotive fluids to the environment.

- Based on these observations, City Wide Towing & Recovery has abated the violation discovered during the November 1, 2011 complaint investigation.

It should be noted that during the site visit City Wide Towing & Recovery had not fully implemented several of the measures to assist in automotive fluid recovery as stated in the November 12, 2011 response. Please notify Ohio EPA when the weather breaks and City Wide Towing & Recovery is able to complete these activities.
