Dear Ms. Brink:

On December 21, 2011, I received Miami Industrial Truck's (MIT) response to Ohio EPA's November 18, 2011, Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. In this response, you explained that Heritage Crystal Clean was currently completing MIT's hazardous waste profiles to address the violation cited in Ohio EPA's NOV and that once you received them you would forward a copy to me.

On January 5, 2012, we had a compliance conference via telephone to discuss the status of MIT's pending hazardous waste profiles. You explained that you were expecting them shortly. On January 25, 2012, George Strobel and I conducted a site visit to get a copy of MIT's hazardous waste profiles. You provided us a copy of these profiles and showed us MIT's used oil, universal and hazardous waste storage areas.

Upon review of MIT's documentation, Ohio EPA has determined that MIT has **abated the violation** discovered during the September 30, 2011 compliance evaluation as listed below:


