This letter acknowledges receipt on February 16, 2012 of correspondence dated February 14, 2012 from Debbie Bishop of Ross Incineration Services Inc. (RIS) responding to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated December 13, 2011.

My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence, which included a copy of the manifest return procedure and training session documentation records, indicates that RIS has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violation cited in my NOV letter of December 13, 2011, specifically:

- Copies of 56 manifests had not been returned to generators within 30 days after delivery as required by OAC 3745-54-71 (A)(2)(d).

That violation was voluntarily disclosed in a letter from RIS to Ohio EPA dated December 9, 2011.
