The Ohio EPA has completed a compliance evaluation of the Monthly Operating Reports covering the months of June 2009 through June 2010 for Behr Dayton Thermal Products. The evaluation indicates a violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0009199; OEPA Permit # 11N00089\*FD). The specific instances of noncompliance are as follows:



I encourage you to ensure that an approved method is being used when effluent monitoring occurs. I also encourage you to ensure that the proper QA/QC is being

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performed for each the analyses.
