The Ohio EPA has completed a compliance evaluation of the Data Monitoring Reports (DMR) covering the months of January through April 2011 for the Behr Dayton Thermal Products. The evaluation indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0009199; OEPA Permit # 11N00089\*FD). The specific instances of noncompliance are as follows:
