The Ohio EPA has completed a compliance evaluation of the Monthly Operating Reports covering the months of January 2009 through May 2009 for Stony Hollow Landfill, Inc.. The evaluation indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0137804; OEPA Permit # 11N00245\*AD). The specific instances of noncompliance are as follows:


