Thank you for your October 5, 2011 e-mail response to Ohio EPA's February 15, 2011 notice of violation letter.

You submitted a photograph showing that used fluorescent bulbs were being stored in a closed and labeled container. Based on the photograph, Blue Ribbon Auto Body has returned to compliance with the violations noted during Ohio EPA's February 9, 2011 inspection:

- 1. Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-273-13(D) (1); Universal Waste Lamp Management Standards; and OAC 3745-273-14(E); Standards for Universal Waste Lamps, failure to label lamps or container of lamps.**

No response to this letter is required.
