RE: New Paris Food Mart Notice of Violation (NOV)

Dear Mr. Singh:

According to our records, the NPDES permit 1PZ00080 for the CFG-Convenient Food and Gas (now known as the New Paris Food Mart) Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) will expire July 31, 2007. The current NPDES permit for this facility states "In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the above date of expiration, the permittee shall submit such information and forms as are required by the Ohio EPA no later than 180 days prior to the above date of expiration."

Ohio EPA has NOT received the Antidegradation Addendum for this facility. NPDES application form 2E, while received, was not signed. Ohio EPA must have form 2E with your original signature on it under item XIII. In addition, as we have discussed in phone conversations, in order to avoid going through the Antidegradation process, Ohio EPA must have on file the signed Permit Transfer Application Form. You have submitted this form, but it was a faxed copy. We need the Permit Transfer Application Form with the original signatures. Please note that in the Permit Transfer Application Form, the New Paris Food Mart owner is the Transferee, and the CFG Convenient Food and Gas owner is the Transferor/Permittee.

Within 10 days of the date of this Notice of Violation you must submit:

1. Completed NPDES form 2E with your original signature.
2. Permit Transfer Application Form with your and the CFG Convenient Food and Gas owner's original signatures.
3. Completed Antidegradation Addendum with your original signature.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the submittal of the renewal application for your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
