Ladies and Gentlemen:

According to our records, there have not been any submittals of required monthly monitoring data for the Billy D. Estes Oil Company NPDES permit 11G00007 for September or October 2010.

As noted previously, the monthly reporting requirement can now be met via Ohio EPA's Electronic Discharge Monitoring Report Submission System (e-DMR). Information regarding the e-DMR system can be found at: <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/edmr/eDMR.aspx>

In the event that there is no discharge for the entire month, an eDMR for the month must still be submitted. In that case select the "No Discharge" check box at the top of the e-DMR form.

Within 30 days of the date of this Notice of Violation you must inform this office, in writing, as to the reason for the above referenced violation, as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations. Your response should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the actions. Please be advised that failure to comply with the NPDES monitoring and reporting requirements may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
