Dear Mr. Croxford:

The following is a review of your self-monitoring report covering the period of August 2006 to February 2007 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of noncompliance and/or deficiencies are as follows:

The above list of violations is abbreviated due to your failure to submit Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) for the period beginning September 2006 to present. Failure to submit the required monthly monitoring data is a violation of your NPDES Permit and ORC 6111.07. Immediately submit the MORs for the period of time specified above.

The NPDES Permit for Knoll Wood MHP expired on September 30, 2006. To date, this office has not received a renewal application to continue coverage under NPDES Permit 0PV00007. Submittal of renewal applications is required 180 days prior to the expiration of the permit. Without coverage under an individual NPDES Permit, Knoll Wood MHP is in violation of ORC 6111.04.


Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111. Please inform this office, in writing, within ten (10) days of receipt of this notification as

to the reasons for the above referenced violations, as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations. Your response should also include a complete and accurate NPDES Permit renewal application.

Due to this facility's long history of noncompliance and your unwillingness to cooperate with this agency, failure to submit an acceptable response to this letter in a timely fashion **WILL** result in enforcement action by the State of Ohio, including civil penalties.
