On July 21, 2011, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) sent Liberty Scrap Tire Monofill Facility a Notice of Violation (NOV) for failure to submit the ten year design demonstration upon the tenth anniversary of the initial permit (February 2, 2001).

On February 1, 2012, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received a document titled "Ten Year Design Demonstration, Scrap Tire Monofill Facility – PTI 02-12980, Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC, Paris Township, Stark County." The document was submitted by Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC in accordance with OAC 3745-27-75(N).

Upon receipt of the ten year design demonstration on February 1, 2012, Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC has returned to compliance with OAC 3745-27-75(N). Also, Ohio EPA has reviewed the ten year design demonstration and has determined that the current design of Liberty Scrap Tire Monofill facility complies with OAC 3745-27-72. Therefore, no further action is required.
