Dear Mr. Melvin:

On February 28, 2012, Dan Bergert and I conducted a complaint investigation at your place of business located at 3531 State Route 335 south of Minford in Scioto County. The complainant indicated that open dumping of solid waste and/or illegal disposal of construction & demolition debris was taking place at the site. At the time of our investigation Mr. Bergert and I viewed the area and discussed our findings with you. Following is a summary of our findings and discussions.

At the time of our investigation we found a large pile of solid waste and construction & demolition debris dumped on the property. The pile contained a number of old spools with leftover cable attached, old furniture, demolition debris, bags of trash and other miscellaneous solid waste. I took a number of pictures while we were at the site. Before we left the site Mr. Bergert and I discussed with you that the waste needed to be removed and properly recycled or disposed of at a licensed facility.

As I indicated during our discussion, open dumping of solid waste or illegal disposal of construction & demolition debris is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). Specifically:

ORC Chapter 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person(s) responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person(s) who allow or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.


OAC Rule 3745-400-04(D) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Please immediately cease all open dumping of solid waste and illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris. All solid waste and construction & demolition debris at the site must be collected and properly disposed of in order to comply with the above mentioned ORC and OAC law and rules. Please retain and provide receipts showing all waste was properly disposed of at a licensed facility or taken to a recycling facility for processing.

Pursuant to our conversation I will conduct a follow-up visit within the next 30-45 days to determine compliance.
