NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Resident:

This letter confirms a visit by the Berne Township Fire Department to your residence at 945 Pump Station Road, Sugar Grove, Ohio wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on February 20, 2012, you were open burning wire and speakers. Additionally, you were open burning residential waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises.

We are also noting that the Berne Township Fire Department was at your residence on June 29, 2011 for a similar incident.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
