NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. McMillion:

This letter confirms a visit by the Pleasant Township Fire Department to your property on February 28, 2012, wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties

Specifically, on February 28, 2012, and at 2855 Lancaster Thornville Road, Lancaster, you were open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises. The fire would not qualify as a pleasure fire since it was about 5 feet in diameter and materials other than seasoned firewood were being burned. Pleasure fires can only have a fuel area of 3 foot in diameter by 2 feet high while burning clean seasoned firewood and must be attended.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
