Dear Mr. Lautersweiler:

This letter confirms our conversation of about March 1, 2012 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 8713 Worthington Road, Alexandria, and on February 27, 2012 you were open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises. Additionally, some of the material was generated offsite.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
