Dear Mr. and Mrs. Rothwell:

Ohio EPA has received a complaint of illegal disposal of plaster at your property located at the above address in Adams County. On January 24, 2012, I conducted a site investigation of this property.

I found the complaint to be valid. Old plaster materials had been dumped along the edge of the highway in the road ditch. This material is classified as construction and demolition debris (C&DD). Placement of C&DD in this manner is considered illegal disposal of C&DD. By rule, C&DD must be disposed of at a licensed disposal facility.

Please be advised that illegal disposal of C&DD is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Specifically:

OAC Rule 2745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris, as defined in rule 3745-400-01 of the Administrative Code.

Based upon my investigation and the evidence obtained, you are currently in violation of the above rules and law.

The illegal disposal of C&DD on your property should cease immediately. All C&DD must be removed from the property and taken to a licensed disposal facility for proper disposal. Please obtain copies of receipts from the approved disposal facility that receives the waste and provide copies to this District Office in order to document your compliance.
