Dear Mr. Lerosé:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection by Ryan Griffin and Rachelle Howe, of the Ohio EPA, at Robert Frost Elementary School located on North Spring Road in Delaware County on July 22, 2009. The purpose of the inspection was to ensure continued compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- The sediment on site appeared to be contained within the disturbed area by the topographical features of the site. Once positive off site drainage is established, sediment controls are expected.
- The site appeared to be under active construction. However, be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.
