This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted on September 2, 2009, of the construction activities at Ashton Crossing, located in Ashville, Ohio. The Agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following was observed or discussed at the site:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

The concrete wash pit needs maintenance. Please install and maintain an adequate concrete wash out containment pit on-site and alert the concrete haulers of its location. Please see attached pictures.

Several new home builds require silt fence and/or dandy bags to prevent erosion on to the streets. Please keep on-site records of the weekly inspections of the erosion controls.


