Dear Mr. Imbrock:

This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted at Cardinal Truss & Components, located at 6868 Canal Road, in Lockbourne, Ohio. The inspection was conducted on February 1, 2010, to determine compliance with your industrial storm water permit. Your company produces wooden and steel trusses. I did not note any discharges from your facility to a storm water drain or waters of the state.

The following items were noted during the inspection:

1. There was used motor oil and other automotive fluids stored outside that should be stored in secondary containment with tight lids or stored inside a building. Please see attached picture.
2. There were used automotive parts (brake pads) stored outside that should be stored with a water-tight cover or stored inside a building. Please see attached picture.
3. There was a storm water drain near the eastern border of your property that had an oily rag stuck in the grates along with a lot of sediment. Oil and other pollutants such as excessive sediment should not be discharged to storm water drains. Please use good housekeeping measures and erosion control measures to prevent oily rags and excessive sediment from getting to the storm water drains on your property. Please see attached picture.
4. Your company had a diesel fueling station located near the entrance of your facility. The fueling station had a spill kit along with a drum of absorbent material. The diesel tank was also in secondary containment. Please continue to use spill kits and secondary containment for your fuel tank.






