Re: Construction Storm Water Inspection at Refugee Road Improvement Project

Dear Mr. Utterback:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Refugee Road Improvement Project located in Pickerington, Ohio on March 22, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- The area is becoming well established with a vegetative cover.

Post Construction Requirements:

- During an earlier inspection in September of 2009 I noted that a gravel berm was installed around the outlet on the eastern pond water quality pond. It is my understanding this gravel berm was set at an elevation to accommodate the required post construction water quality storage. This gravel berm was not present on the western pond during my inspection. Please indicate in your response letter what corrective actions have been taken to address this issue.
