Dear Mr. Stockton:

This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted at The Superior Die, Tool and Machine Company, located at 2301 Fairwood Avenue, Columbus, Ohio. The inspection was conducted on February 23, 2010, to determine compliance with your industrial storm water permit. You stated that you company manufactures components for the automotive industry. I did not note any discharges from your facility to a storm water drain or waters of the state.

The following items were noted during the inspection:

1. The drain to the oil-water separator appeared to be clogged. Snow melt and storm water was backing-up from the drain. The storm water had an oily sheen. Please have the oil water separator pumped immediately and conduct routine maintenance on the separator as needed. Please see attached pictures.
2. Some of the roll-off dumpsters near the oil-water separator were rusted along the bottom and need to be replaced. It is recommended that they be replaced with dumpsters with covers or stored under roof, if possible.
3. Housekeeping around the dumpsters should be better. There was a lot of scrap that was on the ground outside of the dumpsters. Please see attached picture.




