Dear Ms. Mowrey:

On November 21, 2011, the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control issued a Notice of Violation to Shelly Materials. The company installed four new feeders and a new conveyor after primary surge pile at the White Rock Quarry without obtaining the proper air permits. We received PTI/PTO applications from Shelly Materials for the facility on November 28, 2011. The Ohio EPA issued the final General Permit # P0109112 on December 8, 2011. The permit covered the aggregate processing plant with mineral extraction, storage piles, roadways and parking areas.

The issuance of the General PTIO resolves the permitting violation, and returned the White Rock Quarry back into compliance. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
