This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Stephen Riley of the Ohio EPA at CCS Georgian Heights Elementary School located at Salem Drive and Georgian Drive, Columbus, Oh on October 7, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- The sediment and erosion controls at this site are currently functioning properly. Please continue to monitor and ensure continued compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities.
- Since the site is currently in demolition, and construction is not to take place till the spring ; measures are expected to ensure all barren areas are properly protected in preparation for the upcoming winter months. In the event earth disturbing activities extend beyond an effective growing season, alternate erosion protection is expected. This would include but not limited to a crimped straw mulch cover.
