This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Stephen Riley of the Ohio EPA at Del-Co Water Company Inc located at 6658 Olentangy River Road Delaware, Ohio on September 30, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

- The detention basin noted onsite must be modified to address sediment control via the installation of a pond skimmer or an approved alternative. This will allow for additional settling time for the suspended solids to settle prior to a final discharge from the site.
- It was noted that the silt fence adjacent to the parking lot had not yet been entrenched. Mr. Riley was assured by the contractor on site that this would be completed for the end of the business day.
