This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection that I conducted at Cornerstone Estates, located in Baltimore, Ohio, on October 8, 2010. I understand that construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit. Please be aware that the following issues must be addressed prior to construction activity:

**Sediment and Erosion Controls:**

There did not appear to be any construction activity at the site. The site was stabilized and no erosion was leaving the site. Please be aware that if construction activities commence that the General Permit mandates that all barren areas which remain idle areas in excess of 21 days be protected from erosion (i.e., seed and straw), within seven days from the last construction activity.
