Dear Mr. Zellers:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Holiday Inn Express located on 2010 Polaris Parkway, Columbus, Ohio on September 17, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted

Sediment and erosion controls:

- I have noted the recent efforts to correct the bypass associated with the discharge pipe of the centralized sediment basin. However, the bypass still remains. Corrective measures are expected within three days of receiving this letter to implement or install grout to the hole which is evident between the horizontal and vertical pipes associated with the riser.
- I noted the sediment basin was completely dry. This inspection was conducted within 12 hours of a significant precipitation event. It is evident that the bypass is eliminating all sediment storage associated with this impoundment rendering it ineffective.
