This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Glenwood Commons located at the southeast corner of US 36 & State Route 37 & Glenn Road on August 27, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

**Post Construction:**

- The regional wetland/retention pond was evaluated. Please indicate that all plantings, as approved in the General Storm Water Permit, have been completed. If plantings are not completed, please provide a schedule for plantings in order to approve a Notice of Termination.
- In addition, please indicate if all plantings have been completed for the stream restoration as approved by 401 certification. If plantings are not completed, please provide a schedule for plantings in order to approve a Notice of Termination.
