This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection I conducted at Anchor Recycling located at Anchor Recycling in Columbus, Ohio on August 31, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

**Operational Changes:**

- It appears that the access has been eliminated from Claycraft Road and the site appears to be under new management. Please provide the appropriate contact information and complete the transfer of permit ownership if necessary.
