Dear Mr. Berms:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Etna Parkway located on November 4, 2009. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following issues associated with construction activities north of Refugee Road.

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

- The intersection of Broad Street and Etna Parkway remains un-protected void of any effective sediment and/or erosion controls. **Corrective measures are expected within three days from receipt of this letter.**
- Once drainage ditches are established, sediment traps/basins will be expected to ensure effective sediment control. The sediment basin implementation will be closely evaluated to ensure compliance with your permit.
- Additional sediment controls are expected with the construction activities near the stream crossings.
- Please understand, in the event earth disturbing activities extend beyond an effective growing season, **alternate erosion controls such as crimp mulch or equivalent is expected** to ensure effective control through the winter months.
