This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Diley Road Improvement Project on September 29, 2009. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- Please ensure all inlets are properly protected and maintained for areas of active construction.
- All barren areas must be protected from erosion in preparation for the upcoming winter months

Post Construction Requirements:

- The General Storm Water Permit requires specific post construction water quality treatment for all sites.
