Dear Mr. Finnicum:

This letter acknowledges receipt of e-mail correspondence from Julie Juszli of SARTA dated March 14, 2012 responding to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated March 12, 2012.

My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence, which includes photographs of labeled containers of universal waste lamps and a Used Oil sign for the fill-pipe of the used oil underground storage tank, indicates that the Stark Area Regional Transit Authority (SARTA) has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations from the March 1, 2012 inspection cited in my letter of March 12, 2012, specifically:

1. **OAC 3745-273-14(E) Small Quantity Handler Must Label the Unit Holding Universal Waste Lamps**
OAC 3745-273-13(D)(1) Small quantity handler must contain lamps in proper containers or packaging and containers or packaging must be closed.
2. **OAC Rule 3745-52-34(C)(1)(a) Satellite Accumulation Containers Must Be Closed Except When Adding Or Removing Waste**
3. **OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1) Fill pipes to underground storage tanks holding used oil must be labeled with the words "Used Oil"**
