Dear Mr. Weedy:

This letter is written in follow up to a construction storm water inspection by Clarissa Lawlis, of the Ohio EPA, at Fairfield Career Center located at 4000 Columbus-Lancaster Road in Carroll, Ohio on September 14, 2009. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted:

**Barren Areas: 21 Day Rule:**

Be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days (See Figure 1).




