This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Megan Reising and Stephen Riley of the Ohio EPA at Griggs Reservoir Boathouse located at 3033 Thoburn Road in Columbus, Ohio on August 19, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment Erosion Controls:

- The sediment and erosion controls at this site are currently functioning properly. Please continue to monitor and ensure continued compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities.

Post Construction Requirements:

- The General Storm Water Permit requires specific post construction water quality treatment for all sites.
