This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Abigail Tamkin and Stephen Riley of the Ohio EPA located at the Village of Harrisburg Water Distributions System and Wastewater Collection System located in the Village of Harrisburg, Ohio on August 17, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities and to address a complaint of unseeded barren areas associated with the project. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- This site appears to be void of any sediment controls. The General Permit states that all sediment controls must be implemented prior to initial grading of the site. Please implement these controls immediately to ensure compliance with the General Storm Water Permit.
- Failure to implement controls in accordance with your approved Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan is a direct violation of your General Storm Water Permit.
