
This letter is notification that Foxfire Family Fun Park has not complied with requirements issued during this Agency's last survey performed on October 19, 2011, in violation of rule 3745-81-60 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The camp ground was notified in correspondence dated October 26, 2011, to respond in writing within 30 days, with time frames for compliance with the following requirement:

1. Install a self-draining, screened, downturned vent at or above the top of the well casing as discussed during the inspection. [OAC Rule 3745-09-05(T)]

Respond in writing upon receipt of this letter with a time frame for compliance with the above requirement.

Please be advised that my colleague, Janis D'Amico has recently taken over responsibility for public water systems in Crawford County.
