Dear Mr. Thomas:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted of the construction activities at Winchester Park, along Hamilton Road, in Franklin County, on May 3, 2011. I understand this site is currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on my site inspection and the conditions set forth in the General Permit, the following items must be addressed:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

I did not note any active construction at the site.

I noted a small barren area on the west side of the development. Please be aware that the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days. Please maintain the silt fence around the barren area. Please see attached pictures.


