Dear Mr. Biales:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted at Glenwood Commons in Delaware, Ohio on April 4, 2011. The Agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following items must be addressed:

Post Construction:

- The regional wetland/retention pond was evaluated. Please indicate that all plantings, as approved in the General Storm Water Permit, have been completed. If plantings are not completed, please provide a schedule for plantings in order to approve a Notice of Termination.
- In addition, please indicate if all plantings have been completed for the stream restoration as approved in the 401 certification. If plantings are not completed, please provide a schedule for plantings in order to approve a Notice of Termination.

If you have any question regarding this letter or the inspection, please do not hesitate to contact me at our Central District Office at (614) 728-3844. A follow-up inspection will be conducted to ensure the conditions of the General Permit are met.
