Dear Mr. Hebler:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted of the construction activities at the Ety Fair Shoppes aka The Shoppes at Fair & Ety, located in Fairfield County, on May 2, 2011. There did not appear to be any active construction during my site inspection. I understand this site is currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Please consider this a formal notice of violation. Based on my site inspection and the conditions set forth in the General Permit, the following items must be addressed:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

There were several large areas that needed to be stabilized. Please be aware that the General Permit mandates that all barren areas which remain idle areas in excess of 21 days be protected from erosion (i.e., seed and straw), within seven days from the last construction activity. Please see attached pictures.

Please install erosion controls to prevent sediment from discharging on to the road. Please see attached pictures.
