This letter is written our joint storm water investigation we conducted at your facility on March 31, 2011 in follow up to my initial investigation on January 27, 2011. The storm water inspection was conducted to determine your permit requirements pursuant to 40 CFR 122.26.

It is my understanding; you have submitted and obtained a No-Exposure Exemption for this facility as you claim there are no activities or exposed materials, which pose a threat to storm water. The initial inspection question the validity of the NOE.

Based on my observation, I noted all barrels and storage totes located outside the facility were new and empty. There are also large containment vessels for purposes of spill containment. As a result, I agree the NOE is valid. Please understand the NOE must be re-submitted every five years to remain current.
