This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection that I conducted at the Blacklick Creek Greenway Recreation project near the intersection of Shannon Road, Ebright Road and Winchester Pike. The inspection was conducted on May 11, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. It appeared during the inspection that construction activity has been completed for this site and all disturbed areas had been permanently stabilized. Please address the following:

Post Construction Requirements:

The General Permit mandates specific water quality treatment for storm water following the completion of construction (see attachment). Please be able to demonstrate your post construction requirements per the General Permit will be met. Please submit to my attention the water quality calculations demonstrating compliance. This information can be sent to my attention via a response letter, or to my email at greg.sanders@epa.state.oh.us.

If you have not already done so, a Notice of Termination will be required providing that the post construction requirements have been met. Instructions and forms can be found at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/storm/stormform.html>.
