This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection conducted by Stephen Riley and Abigail Tamkin of Ohio EPA at Garfield Mckinley Storm Sewer Project Phase 2 located along Obannon and Garfield Avenues on August 16, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. The following was noted:

Maintenance

- During the inspection our staff observed no signs of displaced sediment moving into local storm drains or channels.
- If displacement of sediment poses threat to local storm drains or channels please emplace sediment controls to these areas.
