Dear Mr. Scott:

On March 31, 2011, Ohio EPA conducted a complaint investigation of your property located at 808 Eastern Avenue in Chillicothe in response to a complaint received by this office. A notice of violation letter was sent to you on April 7, 2011. To date, a response has not been received from you.

Based on my investigation, I found the following violations of Ohio's hazardous waste laws. In order to correct these violations, you must do the following and send me the required information ***within 15 days*** of the date of this letter:

- (1) **OAC Rule 3745-279-22 (D), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators:** Upon detection of a release of used oil to the environment, a used oil generator must stop the release, contain the released used oil, clean up and properly manage the released used oil and materials used to clean up the used oil, and if necessary, repair or replace any leaking used oil storage containers prior to returning them to service for used oil storage.

An estimated 10 gallons of used oil had had leaked onto the ground from a crushed oil tank that was discarded on your property.

To correct this violation, you must clean up the ground where used oil was released by excavating soil until the soil that remains is no longer visibly contaminated with used oil and appears clean. The oil-stained soil that has been excavated should be disposed of at a licensed solid waste landfill. You may wish to contact the landfill prior to taking it there in order to determine if they have any additional requirements for the disposal of this waste. To demonstrate a return to

compliance with this rule, you must send a photograph of all cleaned up areas to this office, and landfill receipts. I also recommend that you scrap or properly dispose of the crushed oil tank and send me documentation of that, as well.
