Dear Mr. Conniff:

This letter confirms a visit to your residence at 320 Brindle Road, Ostrander, by the Scioto Township Fire Department wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on March 12, 2012, you were open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.

Received pre alert of working barn fire on Brindle Rd. Responded with E371 and T371 as first pieces of equipment to respond with personal first to arrive at Station. Contacted DELL COM to what size barn is involved. they answered a full size barn. Requested 2 additional tankers to be added to this run. While en route to scene DELL COM radioed that a secondary structure was on fire per DCSO on scene. That the primary structure was fully involved. relayed to personal in E371 that our primary fire to extinguish was the secondary structure involved. When we marked on scene reported that the primary structure was already collapsed that we were going to make our attack on the secondary structure.

Secondary structure the North side of barn was on fire. Personal extinguished second barn. As I (Lt. Bruce Stayner ) did a 360\* of the perimeter found a brush/rubbish pile the was on fire behind secondary structure with burn path leading to the primary structure fire. pro seeded on around the primary and secondary structures to complete my 360\*. Ask DELCOM if we had a grass unit responding do to field fire to the north of and east of primary structure. They stated no that we did not have any responding at this time did we want one started. I replied not at this time that we would have personal from arriving trucks extinguish field fire. As other responding units arrived I gave them there assignment. Units proceed to extinguish primary and field fire.
