Dear Mr. Mapes:

This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Abigail Tamkin and Vinod Tujalpuram of the Ohio EPA at National Lime and Stone Company located at 2406 South Section Line Road in Delaware, Ohio on July 29, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities.

During the inspection, our staff noted that the ditch relocation appeared to be stable. If provisions for both ditch relocations (to its current location, and back to its original location) are addressed in the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), then coverage under the current permit can continue until completion of the second relocation. If this is not the case, a Notice of Termination (NOT) will need to be submitted for the current project, and a new Notice of Intent (NOI) will need to be submitted for the second relocation.
