Thank you for your January 31, 2012, response to Ohio EPA's December 27, 2011, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). Your response included analytical analysis from the sampling of your facility paint booth filters indicating these filters are a non-hazardous waste. Since your filters are nonhazardous, you may dispose of them as solid waste. Your local solid waste department (Ottawa Sandusky Seneca Solid Waste Management District) should be contacted for approval prior to disposal and please note that your local solid waste landfill may ask you to document that the filters are nonhazardous.

My review of this documentation reveals that Auto-Tech Collision Center, Inc. has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation discovered during the December 6, 2011, inspection as listed below:


