This letter is written regarding the inspection that I conducted on August 30, 2011, at the AHP2 Railroad Spur, located in Lancaster, Ohio. The agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following items must be addressed:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

1. It appears that construction is nearly complete at this site. There is a small barren area that may need to be re-seeded. Please see attached pictures.
2. There were five drums at this site. It is recommended to remove these drums from the site and store in a covered area with secondary containment. Please see attached pictures.




