Dear Mr. & Mrs. Stambaugh:

This office received a complaint on, March 22, 2012, concerning open burning being conducted on your property. My investigation shows construction and demolition debris was burned for disposal purposes within 1000' of adjacent inhabited structures in an unrestricted area.

Based on these findings, there is sufficient evidence to determine that illegal open burning did occur and the complaint is justified. This is a violation of both Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04(A) and Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05. Violations were also discovered by Ohio EPA on your property on, July 5, 2011, and a NOV, along with Ohio's open burning rules, was sent to you on, July 8, 2011, for those violations.

A copy of the OAC rules pertaining to open burning has been enclosed for your review. Please provide a written response acknowledging your receipt of this letter and your understanding of the rules. If you do not understand the rules please contact this office for additional explanation before responding. Your response is requested no later than, April 11, 2012.

Because the fire has been extinguished, you are no longer in violation and the property is considered to have returned to compliance.

Please be advised that the submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make a decision whether to pursue such penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
